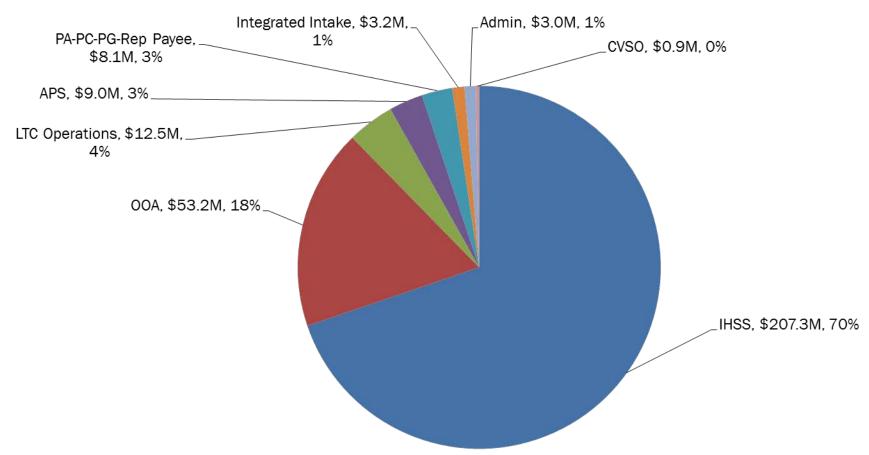

While IHSS comprises the vast majority of the DAAS budget, Office on Aging is the next largest at 18%

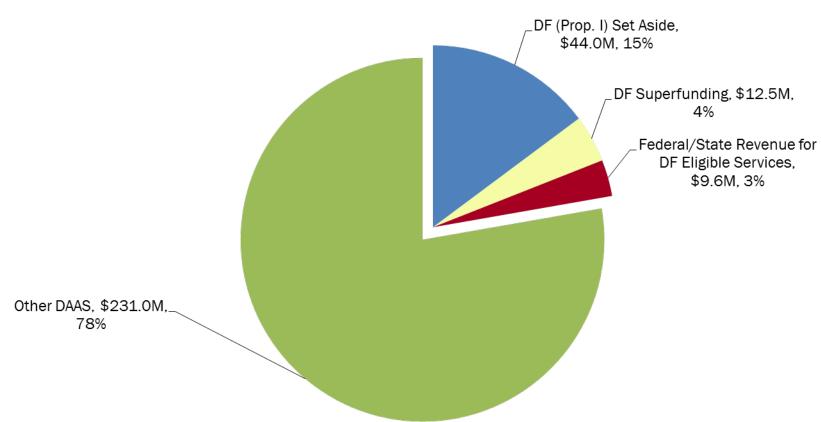
\$297.1M Total FY17-18 Budget

DF Eligible Services comprise 22% of the total DAAS budget

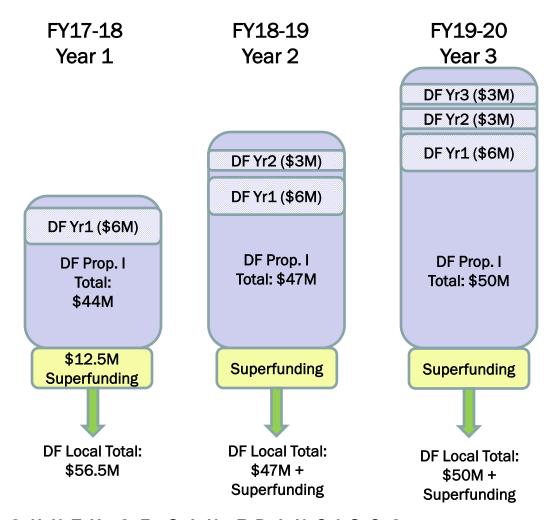
\$66.1M FY17-18 DF Eligible Services



DF FY17-18 Budget Overview

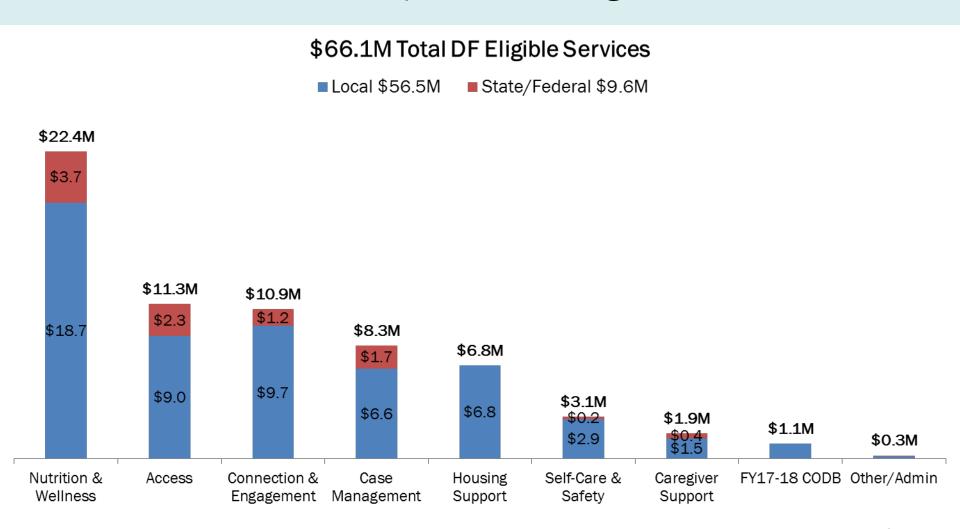
DF Funding Levels (Years 1-3)
