




Distribution of San Francisco Senior Population (60+) by District




Race/Ethnicity of Seniors (65+) by District







Percent of Seniors (65+) in District who Speak English "Not Well" or "Not at All" by Language Group and District





Distribution of LGBT Seniors (60+)* by District





Total Senior Population (65+) by Poverty Status and District




Percent of Seniors (65+) in District who are Low-Income






San Francisco Adults with Disabilities Demographics by Supervisorial District


Race/Ethnicity of Adults (18 to 64) with Disabilities by District

Disability Characteristics of Adults (18 to 64) with Disabilities by District





Percent of Adults (18 to 64) with Disabilities with Incomes < 100% Poverty Threshold by District


